Jane Brucker uses materials—glass, cast metals, textiles, and inherited objects—to commemorate memory and mortality. Her work has been featured at venues throughout the United States and abroad in Nepal, Germany, Scotland, France, Japan, Netherlands and the Czech Republic. Time spent alone as an artist-in-residence at the Scottish Sculpture Workshop Winter Residency in Darkness and Isolation and Künstlerhaus Schloss Plüschow, Germany contributed to melding her interest in contemplation with her current studio practice.

Her degrees include an MFA from The Claremont Graduate University; MA in Religion and the Arts from The Claremont School of Theology. In 1987 she attended the Skowhegan School of Sculpture and Painting, where she was awarded a scholarship to study painting with Agnes Martin and traditional buon' fresco with Lucienne Bloch.

She is a professor and area head of Drawing at Loyola Marymount University in the Department of Art and Art History. She is based in Los Angeles and as co-founder and curator of galerie PLUTO, Bonn, Germany, where she promotes artists, citizens and scholars who engage in a global dialogue on art and science.
